

GCC Membership Covenant

We as a local church of Jesus Christ, having been led by the Spirit of God to repent and believe in the Lord Jesus Christ; now joyfully renew our commitments to God, His mission, and one another. We gladly confess our dependence on Christ working in us to fulfill any of the following.

Our commitments to God:

We commit to live for God's glory in every area of life. We will strive, by God's grace, to live a holy life – denying all ungodliness, while holding fast to the Lord through our profession of faith in Jesus Christ. We aim to draw near to God in corporate worship. We commit to seek the Lord through regular Bible reading and commune with the Lord through regular prayer. We will submit to God's word revealed in Scripture as our final authority.

Our commitments to His Mission:

We will partner together in the gospel by striving with God's help to be faithful to the Great Commission. As good soldiers of Jesus Christ, we will refrain from a civilian lifestyle and strive to finish the mission of our Lord by taking up the evangelistic ministry of reconciliation. We commit to pray fervently for gospel fruit in our city and among the nations. As a local church, we commit to train and send laborers into the all-nations harvest.

Our commitments to one another:

We will not neglect the assembling of ourselves together.
